EYFS Pupil Premium

12% of pupils are eligible for pupil premium - 7 pupils (4 boys and 3 girls).

57% of pupil premium pupils achieved the GLD compared to 77% of non pupil premium pupils. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 20%. The National pupil premium gap is around 17% (PP 52% - NonPP 69%). The pupil premium gap is larger than the National pupil premium gap. Additional support to address specific issues with children has been deployed in Y1. This will support the teaching of phonics and basic skills.

Year 1 Phonics Pupil Premium

12% of pupils are eligible for pupil premium - 7 pupils (4 boys and 3 girls).

100% of pupil premium pupils achieved the expected phonic standard compared to 91% of non pupil premium pupils. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 9%. East Herrington Pupil Premium children's results are better than pupils Nationally. The National pupil premium gap is around 14% (PP 66% - Non PP 80%). The pupil premium gap is smaller than the National pupil premium gap.

KEY STAGE ONE

Maths Pupil Premium

16% of pupils are eligible for pupil premium - 9 pupils (6 boys and 3 girls).

78% of pupil premium pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 76% of non pupil premium pupils. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 2%.

Writing Pupil Premium

16% of pupils are eligible for pupil premium - 9 pupils (6 boys and 3 girls).

67% of pupil premium pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 78% of non pupil premium pupils. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 11%. This equates to 1 pupil.

Reading Pupil Premium

16% of pupils are eligible for pupil premium - 9 pupils (6 boys and 3 girls). Each Pupil Premium child is equivalent to 11% of the Pupil Premium cohort.



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44% of pupil premium pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 82% of non pupil premium pupils. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 37%. Additional TA support and targeted intervention strategies have been put in place to support pupils in Y3 who are not yet working at the expected standard.

KEY STAGE TWO

Reading, Writing & Maths combined Pupil Premium (expected standard)

23% of pupils are eligible for pupil premium - 14 pupils (4 boys and 10 girls).

57% of pupil premium pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 67% of non pupil premium pupils. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 10%. East Herrington Pupil Premium children's results are in line with all pupils Nationally.

Reading Pupil Premium

23% of pupils are eligible for pupil premium - 14 pupils (4 boys and 10 girls).

71% of pupil premium pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 74% of non pupil premium pupils. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 2%. East Herrington Pupil Premium children's results are better than all pupils Nationally.

Writing Pupil Premium

23% of pupils are eligible for pupil premium - 14 pupils (4 boys and 10 girls).

86% of pupil premium pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 91% of non pupil premium pupils. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 6%. East Herrington Pupil Premium children's results are significantly better than all pupils Nationally.

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar Pupil Premium

23% of pupils are eligible for pupil premium - 14 pupils (4 boys and 10 girls).

71% of pupil premium pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 83% of non pupil premium pupils. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 11%. East Herrington Pupil Premium children's results are in line with all pupils Nationally.

Maths Pupil Premium

23% of pupils are eligible for pupil premium - 14 pupils (4 boys and 10 girls).

79% of pupil premium pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 87% of non pupil premium pupils. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 8%. East Herrington Pupil Premium children's results are better than all pupils Nationally.
