<p>The school will do its best to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection and Local Authority Risk assessment ✓ Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can; ✓ Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs; ✓ Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19; ✓ Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' test positive for COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days. ✓ Continue our clear and consistent approach to behaviour using 'Ready, Respectful, Safe' as outlined in our policy. ✓ Communicate between home and school through, Marvellous Me, email and the school 	<p>To help my child at school, I know and understand that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone; ✓ If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately. I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone; ✓ On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules and only one adult will drop off and collect. ✓ When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child and follow the one-way system; ✓ My child will not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school other than a water bottle which is to be filled at home and washed at home on return; ✓ I will not be allowed into the school building. Contact should be made by telephone or email; ✓ I need to be supportive of systems in place and understand that these are there for the safety of everyone; ✓ I will read all messages/emails that are sent home; ✓ I will inform the school of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details; ✓ I will follow the school behaviour policy. 	<p>I will do my best to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Follow the Bubble rules that keep me safe ✓ Tell an adult if I feel poorly; ✓ Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school; ✓ Only use the equipment in my pack. ✓ Not mix with children from other bubbles in the school; ✓ Follow my grown-up's instructions about where to walk and which direction ✓ Follow the catch it-bin it-kill it rules coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue ✓ Wash my hands using soap and water for 20 seconds when asked. ✓ Follow the rules of 'Ready, Respectful and Safe' to keep myself and others safe.
