Updated information from previous letter in July.

What to bring to school

Due to updated advice we recommend that children bring as little as possible into school - we will keep updating this information as we receive further guidelines.

- Children **must** bring their own water bottle to school and this must be named.
- They must have sun cream on before they come to school (There are sun creams available for 8 hours plus in supermarkets to ensure children are safe in the sun)
- Reading books will be able to go home - however, we will have to leave reading books for 72 hours in between other people touching them. Please bear with us as we try to get this system up and running in school. Children can bring a book bag to school with just their book in. Year groups will send information about reading during the first week back.
- Please **do not** bring a bag to school.
- Packed lunches will need to be sent in a disposable bag. If children bring a snack for playtime this will also need to be in a disposable bag.

What to wear to school

- Children will need to wear the **correct school uniform**. Please see the information on the website if you are unsure of this.
- PE kit to be worn on their PE day for school. Year groups will be in touch about the day for PE during the first week.
- Children **must not** wear their new sports hoodies on days that are not their PE days.
