If your child is not able to be in school but in receipt of free school meals, then a school pack lunch will be provided and can be picked up from the school office daily. For those children in school, meals will be provided as normal.

We will be in touch with further information about the work being set for all children and this will be via google classrooms and will be the same work as those attending school to ensure consistency for all children.
